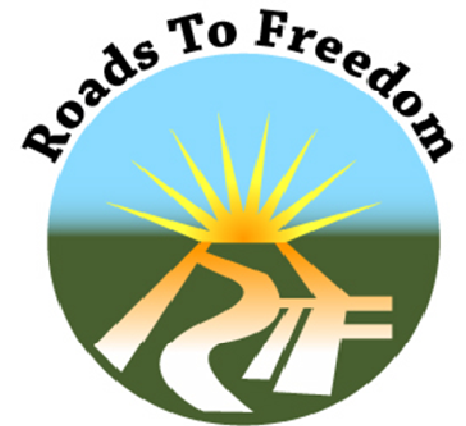

What is Roads To Freedom?

Roads To Freedom (RTF) is a non-residential organization that exists to serve people with disabilities.

MISSION STATEMENT

Our mission is to empower people with all disabilities by providing Resources, Options, and Disability related Services needed to obtain individual freedom in their lives.

What the



Offers:

Life Skills Training: The Center for Independent Living of North Central Pennsylvania (CILNCP) offers training designed to increase self-reliance and self-confidence in the areas of: Housing, Income Benefits, Social/Recreation, Self Care, Mobility/Transportation, Education, Vocation, Communication, Assistive Technology, Sexuality, Service Coordination, Advocacy, and Attendant Care.

Peer Counseling Services: A self-help support service provided to individuals with disabilities by individuals with similar disabilities. Peer Helper Services involves helping others to manage, remove, or cope with barriers they encounter.

Service Coordination: Service Coordination is a distinct service that enables persons with disabilities and their families to find, utilize and coordinate available resources and opportunities in their communities on the basis of their individual needs.

Assistive Technology: This program allows you to try a device for a limited time to be sure it meets your needs at home, on the job, at school, or in your community before you buy it.

Information & Referral: RTF maintains comprehensive information files on availability in their communities of accessible housing; transportation; employment opportunities; rosters of persons available to serve as personal care attendants, interpreters for hearing impaired people, or readers for visually impaired people; and many other services.

Additional Services and Resources:

Free Sign Language Classes: We currently offer three different levels of Sign Language classes. Information is also available on our website, www.cilncp.org. Just click on the gold 'Latest News' star on our home page.

Support Group: RTF offers a support group for the deaf & hard of hearing community, with periodic group activities planned throughout the year.

Telecommunication Device Distribution Program: Pennsylvania's Telecommunication Device Distribution Program (TDDP) provides specialized equipment, FREE, to eligible Pennsylvanians who have disabilities which impede them from having independent access to telephone services. We also provide training for the devices in this program.
